**Action:** Effective September 13, 2018, Massage Therapist License LA8611 issued in the name of Phillip A. Lirette has been revoked.

**Reason for action:** The Louisiana Board of Massage Therapy ("board") has received notice that on August 29, 2018, Phillip A. Lirette entered a plea of guilty to a violation of La. R.S. 14:106, Obscenity, in the 24<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court, Jefferson Parish, Louisiana, Case Number 18-1339. A copy of the commitment order for the charge is attached.

La. R.S. 37:3563 provides as follows:

"(B) Any person who has been convicted or, entered a plea of nolo contendere to, or received deferred adjudication in connection with any criminal offense involving sexual misconduct shall be ineligible for licensure as a massage therapist."

"(C) The board shall revoke the license of any person who is convicted or, entered a plea of nolo contendere to, or receives deferred adjudication in connection with any criminal offense involving sexual misconduct or prostitution."

**Sanctions:** Phillip A. Lirette is prohibited from engaging in the practice of massage therapy and any continuation of such practice is a violation of La. R. S. 37:3556 and may give rise to criminal sanctions under R. S. 37:3565. Notice of such violation will also be provided to the 24<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court.

**Notice of Intent to Contest:** Unless a written Notice of Intent to Contest this revocation is filed with the board office within 15 days of this Notice of Revocation, the revocation will be final and will not be subject to appeal.
