Massage Establishment Licenses "E" Establishment Registration "ER" (Solo Practitioner)

If I work from home or do mobile massage do I need an establishment license or registration?

- No - Your professional license acts as your Establishment License/Registration

I work at a business where I rent space or contract a room, what license do I need?

- Establishment Registration (solo practitioner)

If I work for a business that offers, massage services but do not rent a space, nor am I a contract employee, who is responsible for the Establishment license?

- The business owner is responsible for having the Establishment license and having all massage therapists listed under their Establishment license.

I rent space/contract a room with several massage therapists do we each need an establishment registration (solo practitioner)

- Yes

I own or work at a Salon that is licensed by the Cosmetology Board, does the business or I still need an Establishment License/Solo Registration to offer massage

- Yes

I am a business owner who rents space to massage therapist, or multiple massage therapist, who is responsible for the Establishment license/Registration?

- If you own a business but only rent space to massage therapists, each therapist is responsible for registering as a Solo Practitioner (Establishment Registration).

Do Establishment licenses and Solo Registrations need to be renewed each year?

- Yes – Establishment Licenses are renewed each year for \$100.00. Establishment registrations (Solo Registrations) are free unless renewed late which will be a 100.00 late fee.

Are schools required to have an establishment license?

- Yes - All schools which offer massage therapy services to the public as a part of student training are subject to the same standards that apply to any business providing massage therapy services to the public.

Are there any other restrictions on Establishment License or Establishment Registrations?

- Yes - Only licensed massage therapist can have an Establishment Registration (solo practitioner)

I work at a physician office, physical therapy facility, chiropractic office, or athletic training facility, institution of secondary or higher education were massage therapy is practiced in connection with employment to an athletic team (whether or not they employ, contract with, or rent to massage therapists) Do I need an Establishment License or Establishment Registration?

- No

I work at a medical spa but there is no licensed physician on staff do I need an Establishment License or Establishment Registration?

- Yes, if there is no physician on staff the owner will need an Establishment License or the Massage Therapist will need an Establishment Registration (solo practitioner)
