Due a security breach of the LBMT website, both professional and business licenses renewal applications are being processed manually. This will cause a significant delay in the issuance of all licenses throughout the state. As per La. R.S. 49:977.3(B) all licenses are valid until renewals are processed. (See Below...*the existing license shall not expire until the application has been finally determined by the agency...*)

La. R.S. 49:977.3(B) — *B. When a licensee has made timely and sufficient application for the renewal of a license or a new license with reference to any activity of a continuing nature, the existing license shall not expire until the application has been finally determined by the agency, and, in case the application is denied or the terms of the new license limited, until the last day for seeking review of the agency order or a later date fixed by order of the reviewing court.*

The office is working diligently to process all paper renewal applications and has hired temporary staff to assist. At this time the office cannot provide an estimate of when all licenses will be renewed. Updates will be posted on the website when more information can be provided. Once all licenses are renewed the list of professional and establishment license will be updated and posted on the Public Search page of the website.
